Power Outages

August 23, 2017

Kerrville Public Utility Board (KPUB) officials reported a power outage Wednesday afternoon, August 23, 2017 which affected 1233 customers on the West side of Kerrville, specifically the Trinity Baptist Church and River Oaks Shopping Center areas. The outage occurred at approximately 1:58 p.m. and power was fully restored to all affected customers by 2:30 p.m.

KPUB officials state the outage was caused by an equipment failure at the Harper Substation.
