# Power Outages

May 30, 2017

Kerrville Public Utility Board (KPUB) officials reported a number of scattered and isolated power outages over the Memorial Day weekend in Kerrville and Kerr County due to high winds and lightning. Approximately 60 outages affecting 883 customers system wide were reported as well as numerous blinks throughout KPUB's service area.

The first outage was reported at approximately 5:50 pm on Sunday, May 28, 2017 and the last outage call came in on Monday at 2:28 pm and restored around 6:00 pm.
