Power Outage

May 21, 2018

Kerrville Public Utility Board (KPUB) officials reported a power outage early Sunday morning, which affected 1723 customers in the Coronado/Junction Hwy area west to Greenwood Forest. The outage started at approximately 2:32 a.m., May 20, 2018 and power was fully restored to all affected customers by 3:41 a.m.

KPUB officials state the outage occurred when the circuit switcher at the Jack Furman Substation locked open. The cause of the outage is still under investigation. At this time customers are being served from Ingram and Harper Road Substations.
